1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

2. Pledge of Allegiance

Committee Chairwoman, Dawn Haggerty, led the flag salute.

3. Roll Call

4. Introductions

Everyone in attendance introduced themselves.

5. Accept Meeting Minutes

5.1 July 27, 2016

The minutes were accepted as presented.

6. Animal Control Department Report - Information

Monique Middleton, Animal Control Officer, provided an update on activities and statistics of the Canyon Lake Animal Control.

Dawn Haggerty, Chairwoman, asked a question regarding the percentage of puppies that would get adopted from the shelter.

Officer Middleton, Animal Control Officer, stated that most people look for puppies when adopting from shelters, so the percentage of puppy adoption was high.

Dawn Haggerty, Chairwoman, asked a question regarding if the reduction of services from the Animal Control Department would affect the City's cost or if it was a fixed cost.

Officer Middleton, Animal Control Officer, stated that it was a fixed cost, but there could be months where services would be over the City's hours and that would even things out.

There was discussion regarding the amount of citations issued per complaint, noise nuisance and warning citations.

Officer Middleton, Animal Control Officer, provided an answer to each question.

7. Emergency Preparedness Committee Report – Information

Nancy Carroll, Canyon Lake Emergency Preparedness Committee, introduced Larry Greene, as the new president of the Canyon Lake Emergency Preparedness Committee.

Aaron Palmer, City Manager, stated a letter was sent to the California Department of Forestry requesting answers that had been previously requested from the Riverside County Fire Department, but had not been answered.

10. Special/Code Enforcement Report – Information

Ivan Henery, Special Enforcement Officer, provided an update on activities and statistics of the Canyon Lake Special Enforcement Department.

Leigh Clark, Canyon Lake resident, requested information on a shooting that had occurred two weeks ago in the water, on the north end of the lake. She added that one individual had been shot on the leg, but police were not called.

Ivan Henery, Special Enforcement Officer, stated he was not been aware of a shooting. He added that the City of Canyon Lake had no jurisdiction over the north end of the lake; however, special enforcement does patrol around that area, but they were only able to enforce code violations, any criminal activity observed needed to be addressed to the Canyon Lake Police Department by contacting 911.

Jean Voshall, Code Enforcement Officer, provided an update on activities and statistics of the Canyon Lake Code Enforcement Department.

11. POA Community Patrol

Dawn Haggerty, Chairwoman, provided an update on activities and statistics of the Canyon Lake Property Owners Association.
