1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

2. Pledge of Allegiance

Special Enforcement Officer, Ivan Henery, led the flag salute.

3. Roll Call

Present: Chair Haggerty was absent and Council Member Warren was present with Committee Member Ehrenkranz.

4. Public Comments

Leigh Clark, a Canyon Lake resident, expressed concern regarding the lack of communication between the Canyon Lake Police Department and the Property Owners Association Security Committee. She added that Canyon Lake Police was not aware of the criminal activity that took place inside the Canyon Lake gates. She requested that Canyon Lake Police provide a criminal activity report to the POA's security committee.

Art Femister, a Canyon Lake Resident, stated that the residents of Canyon Lake should get more involved in helping out the police by filing citizen's arrest reports.

Vicki Warren, Councilmember, stated that information was provided on the City's website, Facebook, and the Friday Flyer on the different issues that were handled by the Property Owners Association (POA), the City of Canyon Lake, and the Police Department.

She added that the Federal Government ruled that the advertisement of a vehicle was considered freedom of speech.

Jordan Ehrenkranz, Committee Member, stated he was pleased with the Public Safety meeting turnout and what was accomplished.


14. Staff Member Comments
