**1. Call to Order**

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m.

**2. Pledge of Allegiance**

Mike Borja, Administrative Services Manager, led the flag salute.

**3. Roll Call**

Present: Chair Haggerty was absent and Council Member Warren was present with Committee Member Ehrenkranz.

**4. Public Comments and Introductions**

Everyone in attendance introduced themselves.

**5. Accept Meeting Minutes**

**5.1 June 6, 2016**

The minutes included in the agenda packet were accepted as presented. It was noted that there was no recording or minutes notes provided from the meeting.

Mark Norton, Santa Ana Watershed Project Authority, provided a report on the alum treatments, and stated that the results had shown improvements of the overall lake.

**d. East Bay Coves**

**e. Update on Lake Closure and Reopening**

Vicki Warren, Committee Chairwoman, stated that many residents were not aware of the reopening of the lake. She added that more needed be done to keep residents informed and updated.

Mike Borja, Administrative Services Manager, stated that many residents were not registered for the Code Red alerts, and that it would be a good idea to encourage them to sign up. He added that he would work on putting something together to inform and encourage residents to register.

Nancy Horton, Elsinore Valley Municipal Water District (EVMWD) Board Member, Suggested that the City of Canyon Lake should be testing for algae on a regular basis. She added, that an independent company should be contracted to test the water for algae and the cost should be divided between EVMWD, the Property Owners Association, and the City of Canyon Lake.

There was discussion regarding issuing citations to Canyon Lake residents who launch boats during lake closures.

There was discussion regarding testing the fish in the lake for toxins to ensure that they were edible.

**8. Elsinore Valley Municipal Water District Comments**

**a. EVMWD Oversight of the Alum Treatment Application**

Brian Dickinson, Elsinore Valley Municipal Water District, stated EVMWD would be participating in the alum treatment application as they have in previous years, he added that he would have a boat out on the lake handling that.

Brian Dickinson, Elsinore Valley Municipal Water District, provided an update on when the water treatment plant would be back in service.
