4. Public Comments

Marilyn Moreno, a Canyon Lake Resident, expressed concerned about her safety in the community.

Dawn Haggerty, Committee Chair, requested that everyone in attendance introduce themselves.

6. Animal Control Department Report - Information

Officer Jan Bratton, Animal Friends of the Valley, provided a report on statistics and activities of the Canyon Lake Animal Control.

Dawn Haggerty, Committee Chair, asked a question regarding the average amount of animals that had to be euthanized.

Officer Jan Bratton, Animal Friends of the Valley, stated that euthanizing an animal depended on its behavior and health condition. She added that if the animals are non-aggressive they would be available for adoption in the shelter or sent to a foster home.

Jordan Ehrenkranz, Committee Member, asked a question regarding what kennel/cattery violations were.

Officer Jan Bratton, Animal Friends of the Valley, stated that kennel/cattery violations were people who exceeded the amount of dogs or cats permitted in their city.
