CANYON LAKE VETERANS DAY CELEBRATION

Friday, November 11, 2016

Veterans Day originated as "Armistice Day" on November 11, 1919, the first anniversary of the end of World War I. On the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month of 1918 an armistice, or temporary cessation, of hostilities was declared between the Allied nations and Germany in the First World War.

Congress passed a resolution in 1926 for an annual observance, and November 11th became an official national holiday in 1938. Veterans Day is not to be confused with Memorial Day- a common misunderstanding, according to the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs. Memorial Day (the 4th Monday in May) honors American service members who died in service to their country or as a result of injuries incurred during battle, while Veterans Day pays tribute to all American veterans, living or dead, but especially gives thanks to living veterans who served their country honorably during war or peacetime.

The Canyon Lake Veterans Day Celebration Committee was established in 2009 to formalize a local event honoring the veterans of our community.

Because of the great amount of community support for the Veterans Day Celebration, a fund was established to erect a monument honoring all those who have served, or are currently serving, to preserve our freedom. This Veterans Memorial Monument, and accompanying memorial brick walkway and park, was dedicated on November 11, 2011.

Whether you personally served in one of the branches of our nation's armed forces, are commemorating the service of a family member or friend, or are here to express your gratefulness to those men and women who have, and are serving, we welcome you!
